The Ragged Trousered Philanthropists

This story, about a group of painters and decorators, and their struggle for survival in a complacent and stagnating Edwardian England, has become a classic of working-class literature since its first publication in 1914. A novel of humour and sharply observed characterisation, it is a passionate defence of socialist ideas and one of the first truly imaginative portrayals of life written from a working-class perspective.





Director, Andy Cork, promises political conjuring tricks and live music and song, as the audience joins the performers through the events surrounding the renovation of a large townhouse.
